Special Notices:

1. We may need help with transportation. The unit will pay for fuel for any parent that wants to help with transportation. We should have space for 38 cadets and adults. If we exceed this number we will need additional people and vehicles to transport.
2. **Parents please note the late drop-off and pick-up times at the Bldg. 78 Clay National Guard base.**
3. Bring \$75 in cash to be collected before departing if you have not already paid. If any cadet cannot afford trip, contact the CO to make arrangements. This is one of our best drills and everyone that can, should attend.
4. Required Coursework and Service Records will be collected Friday night before departing.
5. **PT gear is required.** We will PT Sunday morning onboard USS Yorktown.
6. All hands need to bring a copy of this POD to drill. Also, a chronometer is encouraged.
7. If your ID Card has expired or if it will expire prior to Nov.2018, you will need to bring a check in the amount of \$100.00 for re-enrollment. This ensures that you have a current ID Card.
8. Uniform items will be issued as required as per POD.
9. **Sleeping bags and pillow are required. Keep your kit to a minimum as we do not have room for a lot of baggage.**

Standing Orders

1. The appropriate civilian attire (Alternate uniform) for cadets who have not received uniforms is plain dark dress shoes or boots, dark socks, dark blue “dickie” style trousers, belt, plain collared shirt or USNSCC T-shirt, and unit ball cap. No part of the sea cadet uniform will be worn until all parts can be worn appropriately.
2. The USNSCC ID must be on your person at all times while on station or in uniform or during any drill period including travel.
3. No personal gear shall be unattended unless secured in authorized storage as required for station security requirements.
4. Cadets may not operate motor vehicles with other non-family cadets while on station.
5. No cadet may leave drill for any reason, including with adult supervision, without permission of the Command Duty Officer or the Commanding Officer.
6. Cadets are reminded that 80% drill attendance is mandatory in the US Naval Sea Cadet Corps. At least 1 summer training, and completion of 1 course per year is mandatory in the 2745th Seabee Battalion.
