## Special Notices:

1. Parents are invited and encouraged to attend the Awards Ceremony on Sunday 18 Sep at 1500.
2. Bring \$20 per Cadet to help with meal costs.
3. Required Coursework and Service Records will be collected at first Muster on Saturday.
4. All hands need to bring a copy of this POD to drill. Also, a chronometer (watch) is encouraged.
5. If your ID Card has expired or if it expires prior to Oct., you will need to bring a check in the amount of \$100.00 for re-enrollment. This ensures that you have a current ID Card.
6. Uniform items will be issued as required.

## Standing Orders

1. Cadets will **NOT** be released from drill until final muster is complete. This is to ensure the cleanup and securing of our facility is complete.
2. The appropriate civilian attire (**Alternate uniform**) for cadets who have not received uniforms is plain dark dress shoes or boots, dark socks, dark blue “dickie” style trousers, belt, plain collared shirt or USNSCC T-shirt, and unit ball cap. No part of the sea cadet uniform will be worn until all parts can be worn appropriately.
3. The USNSCC ID must be on your person at all times while on station or in uniform or during any drill period including travel.
4. No personal gear shall be unattended unless secured in authorized storage as required for station security requirements.
5. Cadets may not operate motor vehicles with other non-family cadets while on station.
6. No cadet may leave drill for any reason, including with adult supervision, without permission of the Command Duty Officer or the Commanding Officer.
7. Cadets are reminded that 80% drill attendance is mandatory in the US Naval Sea Cadet Corps. At least 1 summer training, and completion of 1 course per year is mandatory in the 2745<sup>th</sup> Seabee Battalion.
